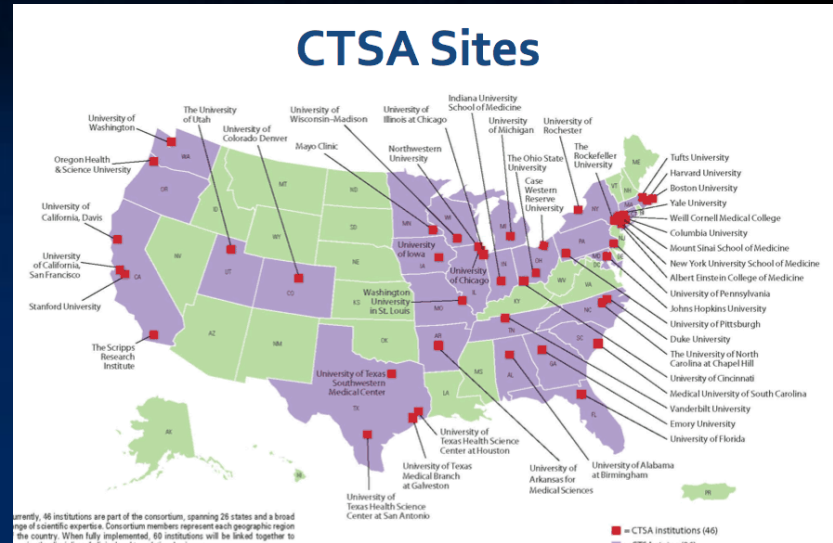

\$21M – amount MICHR has awarded in pilot grants, resulting in \$224M in self-reported extramural funding
